

QUICK & EASY POST IT NOTE HOLDERS

This quick & easy project is great for kids summer parties, camp activities or rainy day fun!



Materials:

Your choice of Sanook Handmade Papers, Paper Flowers & Die Cuts and Little Bits Fibers & Ric-Rack

You'll Also Need:

Double Sided Tape
Post-It Note Pads
ruler
glue

Instructions:

1. Cut a 3 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangle from a piece of handmade paper.
2. With a ruler and stylus or bone folder, score at the following measurements down the length of the piece: at 3 1/2", at 4", and at 7 1/2".
3. Fold the 1/2" tip in and secure with double-stick tape. This will be the top flap of the Post-It Note holder, as the extra weight helps to keep the top of the holder down.
4. Fold the remaining two scored lines in and place a Post-It Note pad inside. Secure the pad to the bottom of the holder with double-stick tape (you can still refill once the pad runs out)
5. Decorate your holder with fibers, ric-rack, paper flowers, and die-cuts!
