## PHOTO FABRIC BAG (No-sew project) By Judi Kauffman

Fabric bags are fun to make. The secret: Stiff fusible interfacing that allows the bag to stand tall!

### Materials:

- 085-0078 Cre8 Canvas Fabric Sheets
- Computer, ink jet printer
- Scanner (optional. If you do not have a digital camera, you'll need a scanner to scan your photos)
- Fabric that coordinates with photo
- Stiff fusible interfacing
- Buttons or other embellishments
- Ribbon for bag handles
- Beacon FabriTac glue
- Bag template  
(Kreate-A-Bag from Greensneakers, [www.greensneakers.com](http://www.greensneakers.com))
- Pinking shears (optional)

### Instructions:

1. Following manufacturer's instructions, fuse fabric to stiff interfacing. Use bag template to construct bag. Use fabric glue to hold bag together and to attach ribbon handles.
2. Print picture and text onto photo fabric. Cut around photo with pinking shears.
3. Glue photo and text block to front of bag.
4. Glue or sew buttons or other embellishments to bag as shown or as desired.
