

Full Moon Frame

Materials:

#90310 Diamond Background Stamp
Stamp
#735-6702 Halloween Scrappers Pack

You'll Also Need:

Purple Grosgrain Ribbon
Orange, Black Acrylic Paint
Wood Craft Frame
Hot Glue Gun
Chipboard (thin cardboard)
Double-sided adhesive
Foam Paint "Brushes"

Instructions:

1. Paint your frame with orange paint. Apply several layers, allowing for proper dry-time between each. (You can speed drying time by using a hair dryer. Be careful to keep the nozzle several inches away from the painted object.)
2. Apply a thin coat of black paint to the Diamond Background stamp and press it carefully to the top right side of the frame. Reapply paint and press to the top left side of the frame, carefully lining up where the diamond pattern meets in the middle. The pattern will go only about halfway down the front of the frame.
3. With a hot glue gun, apply a thin bead of hot glue where the pattern ends across the frame. Lay pieces of ribbon on each side and wrap to back, gluing and snipping ends.
4. Using hot glue, attach a black cat die-cut to the bottom left portion of the frame.
5. Trace moon die-cut onto chipboard (you can use a discarded cereal box) and glue moon onto it. This will give the die-cut more support and protect it from crushing.

6. Adhere witch silhouette to moon and hot glue the whole piece to the top right of the frame.
