

Let it Snow Layout

Materials:

#20071 Let It Snow-Man!
stamp
#10020 Black Stamp Pad

You'll Also Need:

Sage, Dusty Blue, White
Cardstock
Blue Stamping Ink
Lavender, Orange, Green
Brush Markers
Silver Brads
Inkworx Airbrush Tool
Dimensional Adhesive Foam

Instructions:

1. Use one 12 x 12 sheet of Sage Green cardstock as the layout background.
2. Cut White cardstock to 11 1/2 x 11 1/2. Using a Lavender Brush Tip Marker, run tip along edges. Adhere to Sage Green cardstock, centering.
3. On White cardstock, using Blue stamping ink, stamp three snowmen. Ink only the snowmen. Cut each into a 2 1/2" x 2 3/4" square.
4. Decorate each snowman square by highlighting and lightly coloring portions of the design (Orange for the nose, Green for the mittens, and Lavender to highlight the snowman and create a sense of "ground"). Run the Lavender marker around the edges of each square. Load the Inkworx tool with the Lavender marker and spritz, creating "snow."
5. Cut Dusty Blue cardstock to 3 x 3 1/4" three times and edge with Lavender marker. Adhere a snowman to each square in a crooked manner and adhere to the left side of the layout in the same off-center way.
6. Cut three 1/2 x 2 3/4" strips from Sage Green cardstock and stamp "let it snow" in Black ink on each. Adhere to layout over each square, fastening with silver brads.
7. Take a 4 x 6 photo and mat with a 1/8" White cardstock mat. Adhere to a 4 3/4 x 6 3/4 mat made from Dusty Blue cardstock and attach to right side of layout with dimensional adhesive foam squares.
8. Computer-generate journaling block on White cardstock. Trim and highlight with Lavender and Green markers. Edge with Lavender and spritz with the same color in your Inkworx tool.

9. Mat journaling block with Sage Green cardstock and edge with Lavender marker. Adhere to layout under photo.
