

# Pumpkin & Bat Frame

## Materials:

#735-6702 Halloween Scrapper's Pack

## You'll Also Need:

Black, Purple, Orange Acrylic Paint

Wooden Craft Frame

Ribbon

Hot Glue Gun

Foam Paint "Brush"

Old toothbrush

## Instructions:

1. Paint the top two-thirds of your frame with purple acrylic paint and the bottom third with black. Apply several coats, allowing adequate dry-time in between.
2. With an old toothbrush, dip brush tips into orange paint and flick the ends with your thumb, holding the brush several inches away from the frame. This adds a dimensional, speckled look to the finish. Let dry.
3. Run a bead of hot glue where the purple paint meets the black paint and attach the ribbon to each side, securing with more hot glue in back.
4. With glue gun, carefully apply hot glue to the pumpkins and bat die-cuts, adhering them to the frame.
