


WRAPPED & BEADED HAIR COMB

Materials:

Variety of DFN Embroidery floss colors
Tacky Glue
Hair Comb
Assortment of Beads

Instructions:

1. Decide how you would like the colors arranged. Starting at one end of the hair comb, glue the end of the first color floss to the back and simply wrap it over the edge of the comb. Continue, changing colors as you desire.
2. When the edge of the comb has been completely wrapped in floss, use your finger to lightly brush glue over the top of the floss. Attach small beads to the top of the floss, above each tooth of the comb. Be sure to securely glue the backside as well. Allow to dry.
3. Cut a 1 strand piece of floss that is double the length of the string of beads you desire. You will be stringing the beads from the bottom up. Be sure to plan your bead placement accordingly. Using a needle, thread one strand of floss through the bottom bead. Once the needle is through, thread BOTH ends of the floss through the needle. Continue stringing the beads. This creates a finished end for the bottom.
4. When you have finished beading, attach the strand to the comb's long straight edge, Wrap the ends up and over between the comb's teeth. Wrap the floss a few times, and then finish with drop of glue. Be sure the ends of the floss are trimmed and no loose pieces are visible. Repeat this beading method for the remainder of beads.

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
