## Flower Kitty Card

## Materials:

#90087 Watercolor Pallet #90077 Watercolor Cards #10020 Memories Inkpad #60081 Flower Cat stamp

## You will Also Need:

flowers, white ric-rack, white button Large Scallop-edged scissors Brush White, Purple, Orange Cardstock Tissue or Paper Towel

## Instructions:

- 1. Take your other, unused portion of watercolor card and paint several blocks of color randomly on its surface. Let the colors meet and wash into one another at the edges. Let dry.
- 2. Stamp Flower Cat over watercoloring in black ink. Let dry.
- 3. Trim along the right and left sides with large scalloped scissors. Tear along the top and bottom . The piece should roughly measure  $4.25 \times 4$ . Adhere to a  $4.75 \times 4.5$  piece of white cardstock.
- 4. Adhere to a piece of 5 x 4.75 yellow cardstock. Adhere entire piece to the top left corner of a 6 x 6 piece of purple cardstock, leaving a slim margin on the top and left sides.
- 5. Run a piece of white rick-rack along the bottom portion, fastening in back with double-sided tape. Adhere a purple paper flower and white button to the bottom right corner.
- 6. Attach entire card front to a 6 x 6 card body (fold a 6 x 12 piece of white cardstock in half to create).
